The unique feature of the revised curriculum of the 4 Year Honors Degree is a 10 month mandatory internship/apprenticeship/on the job training, which IIIrd and IVth Semester students have to do community service project and internship for two months and V th and VI th Semester Students have to undergo for six months of internship/ apprenticeship /on the job training was an integral part.

To ensure effective implementation of the mandatory 10-month internship for the students of Colleges under University, and on the recommendation of the A.P. State Council of Higher Education, the Government of Andhra Pradesh constituted State Level and district level internship coordination committees in each of the districts of Andhra Pradesh. The state level committee is chaired by Chief Secretary, Go AP and District level committee is chaired by District collector with the following mandate support.

- ✓ Regular follow-ups with collectorat section officers a committee constitution and following things are done.
- ✓ Scheduled meetings with the local industrialists, service organizations, Government departments, agencies and other professionals, to explore the possibilities of the internship/apprenticeship /on the job training in the respective organizations and establishments.
- ✓ Explore the possibilities of vacancies for internship / apprenticeship on the job training in various organizations and industries/ establishments, both in public and private and in Central and State Government Departments and empanel professionals/small business establishments and other agencies which can offer internships.
- ✓ To ensure the implementation of the provisions of Apprenticeship Act wherever applicable.
- ✓ To review periodically the effectiveness of internship programme in consultation with all the stakeholders. To ensure that all the students are provided with internships preferably as per their interests and domain of study.

bllector Kadapa had introduced readymade Application (APP) to Allot and monitor all internships allotments and to redress the issues for smooth functions of Internships. Created an email (<a href="mailto:yvuinternships@gmail.com">yvuinternships@gmail.com</a>) and a provision made available for the benefit of students to share their issues regarding internships. Emails are being received from many candidates stating with issues, at the allotted firms, and with the support of HOSDs it was redressed.

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




